Appointment of Auditor to audit accounts of the National Foundation for Communal Harmony during the years 2018-19 and 2019-20 invitation of applications - reg.

The National Foundation for Communal Harmony (NFCH) is an autonomous organization under the Ministry of Home Affairs, registered in 1992 under the Societies Registration Act of 1860. The Foundation was set up with the main objective of providing assistance for rehabilitation of child victims of communal, caste, ethnic or terrorist violence, with special reference to their care and education, besides promoting communal harmony and national integration.

The Foundation is required to prepare the Annual Statement of income and expenditure for each financial year duly prepared and audited by a firm of Chartered Accountants which is required to be approved by the Governing Council, NFCH. Such Statement of Accounts for each financial year is included in the Annual Report of the Foundation to be laid in both Houses of Parliament immediately after completion of the financial year.

Donations received by the Foundation are exempted from Income Tax under section 80G(2)(a)(iii(e)) of the Income Tax Act 1961.
