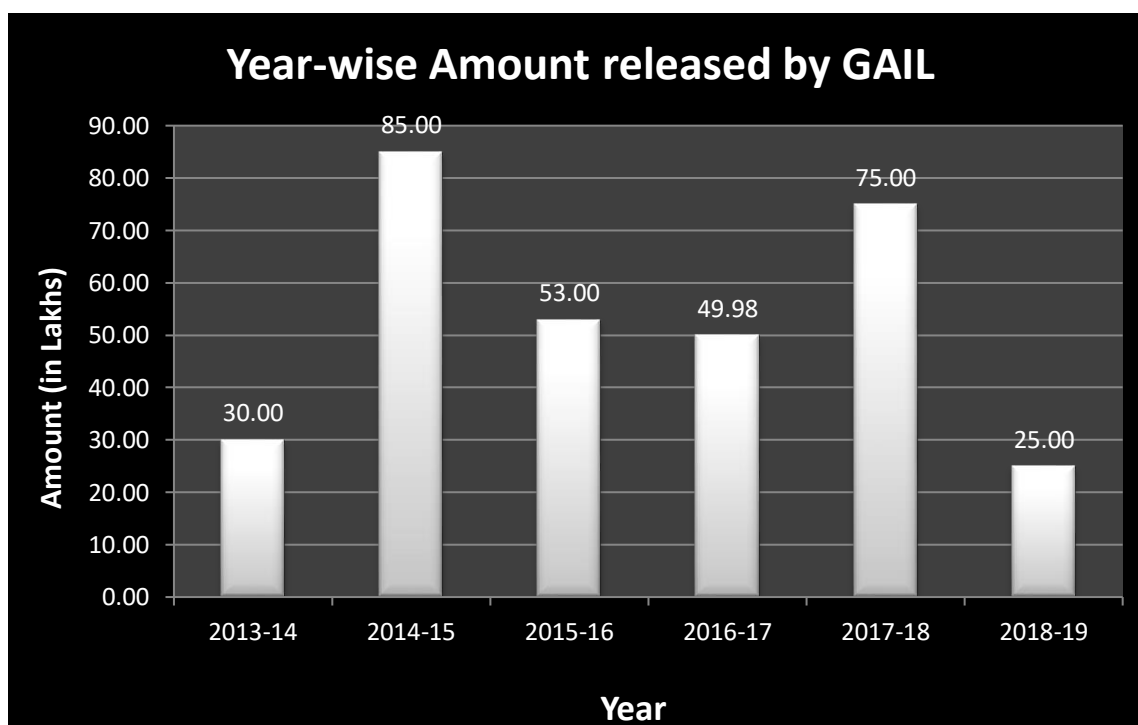




GAIL (India) Limited

GAIL India Limited in collaboration with National Foundation Communal Harmony under project “Assist” has agreed to provide financial support to children who are rendered destitute/ orphan in any kind of Communal/ Caste/ Ethnic/ Terrorist Violence for their care, rehabilitation and education under CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility).

Since 2013, GAIL has been continuously contributing and supporting for the welfare of these children and has released Rs.3,17,98,000 and supported 1680 children till 31.03.2019 under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR).



During the current year 2019-20, GAIL has agreed to provide an assistance of Rs. 1.61 Crore for 1073 such children in Assam, Jammu & Kashmir, Manipur and Chhattisgarh and has signed an MoU with NFCH to this effect.

Districts covered in Assam, Manipur and Chhattisgarh States and Jammu & Kashmir U.T. for assistance to such children are as under:
